

# DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT

pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

**BETWEEN:**

**CORY RAIVIO, #83,910**  
(the “**Registrant**”)

and

**College of Registered Nurses of Alberta**  
(the “**College**”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Registrant and the College, dated with effect January 12, 2024. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through an Agreement with the College, Cory Raivio, #83,910 (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to the College including the following:

- On or around October 29, 2021, the Registrant failed to practice ethically when they diverted Meperidine from pyxis for their personal use.
- On or around October 29, 2021, the Registrant failed to adequately monitor their fitness to practice as a RN when they failed to report that they were suffering from addiction to CRNA or their employer.

The Registrant agreed to complete coursework and a behavior improvement plan. The Registrant agreed to pay a fine, provide a letter from a physician and complete a period of employer reference. Conditions shall appear on the College register and on the Registrant’s practice permit.
