

# DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT

pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

**BETWEEN:**

**ROZEENA RAJANI, #107,179**  
(the “**Registrant**”)

and

**College and Association of Registered Nurses of Alberta**  
also known as **College of Registered Nurses of Alberta**  
(the “**College**”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Registrant and the College, dated with effect **September 19, 2022**. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through a DCRA with the College, ROZEENA RAJANI, #107,179 (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to the College include the following:

- In 2022, and on approximately one hundred fifteen (115) occasions, the Registrant failed to demonstrate adequate judgment and failed to insure a client’s right to confidentiality and privacy when they accessed personal health care records of numerous persons, including their ex-family members, their family members, and patients that were not under the Registrant’s care, and where there was no immediate care relationship for any of the persons.
- In 2022, and on approximately fifteen (15) occasions, the Registrant failed to demonstrate adequate judgment when they accessed their own personal health care records when they were not authorized to do so.

Registrant agreed to complete coursework on the importance of privacy in health care, write a paper on maintaining confidentiality and privacy of health care information and they must pay a fine. Conditions shall appear on the College register and on the Registrant’s practice permit
