In the Continuing Competence Standards, there are nine criteria under standard one that you must meet to renew your permit. You can use this document to complete a self-assessment on your nursing practice to meet criteria one — document self-assessment. **This tool is an optional resource.**

How to Meet Criteria 1.1

Write down your assessment of your practice against the four standards in the *Practice Standards for Registrants*. After assessment, pick the indicator that will be the focus of your learning goal. You will use the answers to inform your next continuing competence steps (criteria 1.2 to 1.7).

How to Review Your Practice

You can review each of the standard indicators below and rate your level of competence against the scale of 'knows', 'knows how', 'shows' and 'does'. If you select option 'know' or 'knows how', summarize why in the space provided after the indicators. If using this method, the levels of competence are:

- 1. **Knows** I require more education for this indicator and how it applies to my role and practice setting.
- 2. Knows How I understand this indicator and how it applies to my role and practice setting, but my ability to demonstrate this behaviour could be enhanced.
- **3.** Shows (Minimum Competence) I can satisfactorily demonstrate this indicator, at minimum, in my specific role and practice setting.
- 4. **Does** This indicator is well integrated into my specific role and practice setting.
