

DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT

pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

BETWEEN:

KATHERINE GOMEZ, #73,638
(the “Registrant”)

and

College and Association of Registered Nurses of Alberta
also known as **College of Registered Nurses of Alberta**
(the “College”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“DCRA”) was executed between the Registrant and the College, dated with effect November 28, 2023. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through an Agreement with the College, KATHERINE GOMEZ, #73,638 (the “Registrant”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to the College include the following:

- The Registrant demonstrated a lack of knowledge, skill, and/or judgment when they:
 - In 2023, inserted a foley catheter in a patient’s uterus;
 - In 2023, the Registrant required coaching from their employer on missing post-fall vital signs on two different patients; and
 - In 2023, the Registrant released a patient’s body to a funeral home without notifying the physician.
- The Registrant failed to adequately document their patient care and/or process orders correctly, when they:
 - In, 2023, the Registrant failed to accurately and/or adequately document their insertion of a foley catheter; and
 - In 2022, the Registrant required coaching from their employer on proper documentation and processing of orders.

The Registrant agreed to complete course work on nursing process and documentation and provide a practice report letter covering a total of 330 practice hours. Conditions shall appear on the College register and on the Registrant’s practice permit.
