

# DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT

pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

**BETWEEN:**

**JENNIFER DUNN, #79,542**  
(the “**Registrant**”)

and

**College and Association of Registered Nurses of Alberta**  
**also known as College of Registered Nurses of Alberta**  
(the “**College**”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Registrant and the College, dated with effect **August 19, 2022**. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through a DCRA with the College, JENNIFER DUNN, #79,542 (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to the College include the following:

- Over a period of approximately one (1) year, the Registrant failed to act honestly and with integrity when they submitted numerous fraudulent claims to their employer insurance provider for services not provided.

The Registrant agreed to complete course work, pay a fine, provide a Behavior Improvement Plan focused on improving professionalism and must provide employer notifications for a period of two (2) years. Conditions shall appear on the College register and on the Registrant’s practice permit.
